populous state in the country. Maharashtra is one of the topmost travel destinations in the country. Its traditional culture and natural beauty define the states, this state is a very good destination for all kinds of travelers who love to explore archeological treasures, museums, trekking, religious sites, cultural tours, crowded sea beaches, wildlife sanctuaries, biodiversity, flora & fauna. #### STATE OVERVIEW

The State has a geographical area of **307,713 sq km** which is the **3rd** largest position in terms of the geographical area in India & divided into a total of 36 districts. It is bounded by the Indian states Madhya Pradesh to the north, Chhattisgarh to the east, Karnataka to the south, Telangana to the southeast, the Arabian Sea to the west, Gujarat to the northwest, and Goa to the southwest part. The total population of the state is approx. 12.3 crores in 2020.

Mumbai is the state capital of Maharashtra

#### **CLIMATE**

Generally, Maharashtra has a warm and pleasant climate. The average temperature here is between 30 and 33 degrees.



During summertime (**March** to June), the temperature here is between **26** to **37** degrees



In the monsoon time (**July to** During wintertime **October**), the temperature here is between **24** to **30** degrees



(November to February), the temperature here is between 18 to 28 degrees

#### BEST TIME TO VISIT

Traveling to Maharashtra in the monsoon - **June to August** season and winter season -**November to February** would be the best time to visit.



Maharashtra is well connected with all major cities of the country by road, airport, and rail services. Domestic & International air services are available for own & foreign tourist also.



The three main International airports in Maharashtra for passenger services are Chhatrapati Shivaji International Airport, which is located in the state capital, Mumbai, Pune International Airport which is located in Pune, and Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar International Airport which is located in Nagpur. Apart from this, there are several domestic airports in Maharashtra from where tourists can easily get taxi and bus services to reach their destinations.



Maharashtra is one of the most important railways in the country. The state is well connected by rail with all the cities. Apart from the capital Mumbai, the state has several major railway stations such as Pune, Lokmanya Tilak, Nagpur, Thane, Amravati, and Nasik from where local and express train services are connected to the rest of the states in the country.



There is very well-connected and dependable road connectivity through national and state highways in Maharashtra which is connected to most of the part of the country.

There are several purposes of traveling in Maharashtra such as trekking, excellent hill station, wildlife, biodiversity, cultural travel, religious travel, heritage trekking, exploring historical monuments, crowded beaches, various activities, famous festivals, and its food.






