The Rajasthan Tourism Development Corporation may soon reach an agreement with the Railways in this regard. The Palace on wheels is one of the major attractions of the tourism industry in the state. But for the last two years, the train service has been closed due to a lack of tourists. This is a luxury tourist train. It was launched in collaboration with Indian Railways and Rajasthan Tourism Development Corporation. Today it is known as Heritage Palace and wheels. This train can carry a total of 104 tourists. The train has a total of 23 bogies named after the Rajput states. Each cabin has a luxury room with Wi-Fi internet facilities, two restaurants – named Maharaja and Maharani, a bar cum lounge and 14 saloons, and a spa.
